for kids with special needs 10 to 17 years old

The United Special Sportsman Alliance in conjunction with bear hunters and bear groups will be sponsoring free hunts throughout the state of WI. These are individual hunts, and the date and location are coordinated by the hunting guide. (See chart below for more information on bear season dates.)

If you know any youth with special needs between the age of 10-17 years interested in attending a bear hunt, please contact us. All hunters must attend the hunt with a parent, guardian, or an adult relative. We require they have firearm experience and their USSA youth application on file before the hunt. Hunter safety is not required to participate, but we recommend your child take the course when available in your area. **Note:** An adaptive shooting device is available upon request. **Important:** a child cannot apply if he or she has been on a Wisconsin Bear Hunt.

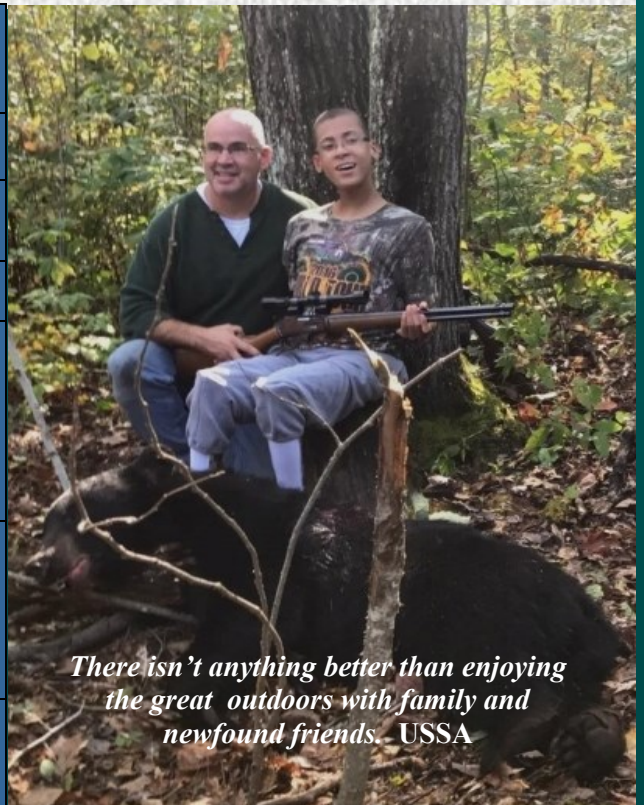
Bear Season Dates
