- **Hunting schedule:**

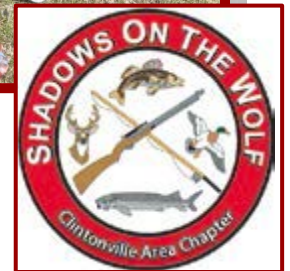
Saturday- 5:45 a.m. until closing.
