This is a learn-to-hunt event, so the hunter should not have harvested a turkey before. Although the hunter safety course is not mandatory, it is highly recommended. The event includes lodging, meals and supplies at no cost. However, lodging is limited to the hunter and an assisted mentor who can be a parent, grandparent, relative, etc. To attend the event, you need to register by calling (800) 518-8019 or by email and submitting a USSA youth application before the event. Please note that it is mandatory for your child to have a Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources free Customer ID Number to participate in any Wisconsin hunt. To obtain the number, please call (888) 936-7463 between 7:00 AM and 10:00 PM. or apply online. You will be required to provide your child's social security number and date of birth. This number has no expiration date and will be required for future hunting licenses.

Information about the hunt: Indoor training is mandatory and will start on April 4th at 3:30 pm, followed by a sight-in-clinic. The turkey hunt will be on April 5th and 6th.

Saturday: 5:45 am until closing. Sunday: 5:45 am until 10:30 am. There will be a picnic on Sunday from 11:30 am to 1 pm, followed by a short program from 1:00 pm to 2:30 pm.
